Any Who Seek

Read Jeremiah 29:13 When we seek Him what will we find?

God wants to be found I love this thought!

How are we to seek Him?

This thought challenges me. I do many things with all my heart. I am competitive at games. I put everything into mothering my children, caring for our home, and serving in ministry. Jeremiah 29:13 forges a challenging question: do I seek God with the same vigor and determination in which I seek other things in my life?

What do you seek with all your heart?

Several years ago, in an attempt to change the direction of my unhappy, happily-ever-after, I began to spend time seeking God. Reflecting back makes me chuckle, almost out loud. You see, I had no idea how to seek God nor what it meant. What I did know, was that I was miserable and had tried other things with all my heart with a zero return on my investment.

I begin to pray a simple prayer, "Lord help me love you" and then added, "Satisfy me in the morning with your unfailing love that I might sing for joy and be glad all my days." (Psalm 90:14) Do you know what He did? He answered me.
