Numbers 7:1

Tabernacle as a noun

- Tabernacle: dwelling place, habitation, tabernacle, tent

Tabernacle as a verb:

- is dwelling in intimate communion with the resurrected Christ –

And the Word became flesh, and did tabernacle among us, and we beheld His glory, glory as of an only begotten of a Father, full of grace and truth.”

John 1:14 YLT (Young’s Literal Translation)
