We studied this week that obedience is how a trust relationship with God is cultivated.



But what if we don't want to obey. Let's call them the "what ifs"

- Don't want to.
- Didn't request it.
- Don't feel qualified.

Would God ask me to do something that doesn't make any sense, I don't want to do, or feel qualified to accomplish?

Yes. Yes, He would. History says yes.

Think of: - Noah – Isaac – Jonah – David – The Prophets

Trust is cultivated each time we allow it to supersede all the what ifs.

- Confirm the assignment through prayer, counsel, and reading the Bible.
- Confidently proceed with the instructions.
- Complete the assignment and leave the outcome to God.

Truths to tuck away for later

- We are responsible for the obedience, not the outcome.
- The results of our obedience rests on God's shoulders, not ours.

Obedience hinges on one word, love; and love holds hands with trust.

- If you love me, obey me John 14:14 TLB (John 15:10, John 15:14, 1 John 5:3)
- The Lord is my strength and shield. I trusted him with all my heart. He helped me, so I am happy. I sing songs of praise to him.
